

Drum and Disc Brake Axle and Suspension Warranty

SAF-Holland SA warrants all Drum and Disc braked axles and suspensions manufactured by it, when correctly installed, to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service for a period of:

12 Months or 160,000KMS which ever comes first

From the date of first registration of the vehicle

Excluded from the warranty are normal wear and tear items, component failure due to contamination from an external source, damage due to extreme force, incorrect operation and/or subsequent damage.

Brake Balance between the truck and trailer must be checked regularly and any resultant damage, including that of wheel bearings, will not be warrantable if the balance is out side recommendation.

Damage to components, including premature brake lining wear, through Brake Code specifications being used, which differ from our specified data, will not be covered under the terms of this warranty.

Regular inspection and preventative maintenance procedures must be carried out in accordance with the SAF maintenance manual. To validate this warranty the Gough Transpecs (Transpecs) 5000kms or 1 month service must have been carried out by an authorised workshop, within the correct time frame.

The use of non genuine parts, including friction material, invalidates this warranty.

Warranty is void on this product if any alterations or modifications have been carried out to it out side SAF-Holland normal service bulletins.

No charges for transportation or labour performed on SAF-Holland products by unauthorised persons will be allowed under this warranty.

Neither SAF-Holland nor Transpecs shall be liable , in any event, for proximate, incidental, consequential or other damages for the loss of production or injury or property arising from any claim on this warranty

Before any repairs are carried out that may involve warranty, an authorisation number must be obtained from Transpecs and a service report form completed.

Full details of the warranty terms, conditions and procedures are laid out in the Transpecs SAF warranty handbook.
